



## CENTRAL SIGN-ON OVERVIEW

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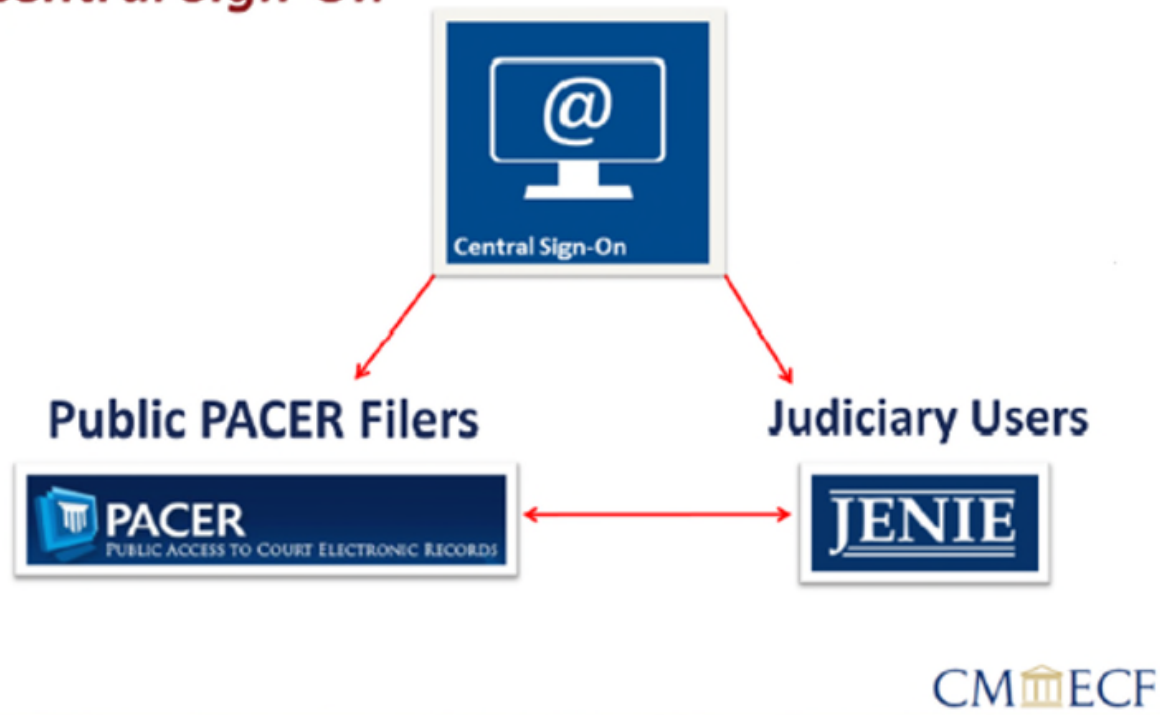
# *Central Sign-On CSO Logins*



- One login for each CM/ECF user.
- One login to access multiple courts.
- One login and password to access both NextGen and CurrentGen CM/ECF.
- Logins no longer shared among users.
- Single sign-on logins belong to the user and will follow the user to a different court, a different attorney firm, or different business.

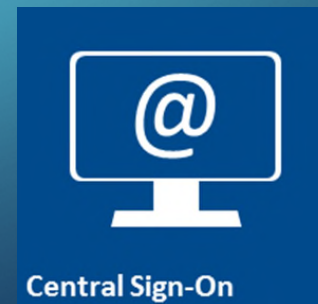

# *Central Sign-On for Non-Court Users*



## PACER Service Center Will Manage:

- Single ID/password validation
- New PACER and CM/ECF registration and logins
  - No longer through the court
- Sending new user access requests to the court
- Centralized credit card information



## *Central Sign-On for Non-Court Users*



- Existing Attorneys must link their upgraded PACER account to their CM/ECF logins the first time they file in a NextGen court.
- New Attorneys will create their Pacer Account and courts will be notified and the court will manage access privileges to their court.
- Attorney firms can have an administrative account for centralized Pacer billing.





## Things you can do now prior to Court converting to NextGen.

- 1. Obtain your own Individual PACER account, or upgrade your existing PACER account
- 2. Know your current ECF Login and Password.
- 3. Once Court has converted to NextGen filers will need to link their PACER account to their ECF account. **(Please note this step cannot be performed until the court is Live on NextGen)**
